Essential Duties:

- Performs diagnostic tests and procedures including proficiency testing, culturing for bacteriological tests, and regular/routine quality control testing
- Performs preliminary reading for bacteriological growth on plate media
- Performs microscopic examinations as required
- Reviews performance and quality of laboratory procedures and testing performed by staff
- Monitors systems/information/specimen flow to ensure compliance and efficiency
- Inventories laboratory supplies in absence of Laboratory Associate Director, disposes of hazardous waste materials per OSHA and CLIA guidelines.
- Works closely with Laboratory Associate Director to prepare for CLIA and other regulatory inspections and /or audits.
