Site Updates for At-Risk Youth

\$10,000

Our CHC - Pearl Street practice, that serves at-risk and/or homeless youth, was damaged by unexpected flooding and requires new flooring. This update is needed to create and maintain a warm and welcoming feel for the young people coming in for care.

Distraction Toys for Laboratory \$1,500

Our pediatric patients sometimes have upsetting times getting their blood drawn in our laboratories. It would be helpful to have a supply of toys to help distract them, and then give them a prize to help them recover when it's all over.

Bus Passes for Patients

\$125

Many of our patients rely on the bus system to get to and from their appointments. This will provide 100 bus passes.

Nursing Education Items \$2,000

The Nursing Education Program implements, designs, assesses, and modifies the clinical training for our nursing staff in order for them to achieve excellency in providing evidencedbased nursing care in the clinical setting. Needed items include a CPR manikin, skin and vein replacement kits, and phlebotomy arm tubing sealant to name a few.

HemoCue Machine \$800

This machine measures hemoglobin level with finger sticks versus venous blood draws, and gives instant results.

Portable Automatic Vital Sign Machines \$1,600 each

Eight machines are needed to allow clinical staff to verify hard to read/hear vitals and can be used in emergency situations where vital signs need to be consistently monitored.

Phlebotomy Arm Supports \$125 each

We would like 16 mobile arm rests to help eliminate one of the biggest challenges to drawing patients' blood in exam rooms and make the procedure a safer and more comfortable experience.

Maternal/Child **Health Program** \$1,000

Our OB Team provides support services to new mothers and has an ongoing need for helpful supplies including diapers, home automatic digital blood pressure monitors, Nepali children's books. and trinkets for our toy boxes.
